# Media Release

## EVACUATION ALERTS LIFTED

The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George is advising it has lifted all evacuation alerts within its boundaries as of 15:00hrs on May 30, 2015.

The areas under evacuation alert were the Bednesti Lake, Berman Lake and Dahl Lake Road area and the Norman Lake area. Evacuation alerts in those areas have been removed. There were 252 properties in those evacuation alert areas. No structures were lost as a result of the Little Bobtail Lake fire.

Fire crews have made significant progress on the Little Bobtail Lake fire, and while it continues to burn, the risk to public safety and personal property has diminished.

While the threat from this fire has diminished, the Regional District is advising the public take extreme care in the woods. Open fires are banned within the Prince George Fire Centre area, and campfires must not be larger than 0.5 metres by 0.5 metres, or about 19 inches by 19 inches, and you must have a shovel or at least eight litres of water nearby to extinguish the fire

Additionally, recreationalists in the area are encouraged to avoid going into the surrounding areas of the Little Bobtail Lake wildfire. It is still an active fire and crews remain on site working the fire. For the safety of the crews and the public, it is advised that recreationalists find other places to go while this wildfire remains active.
