



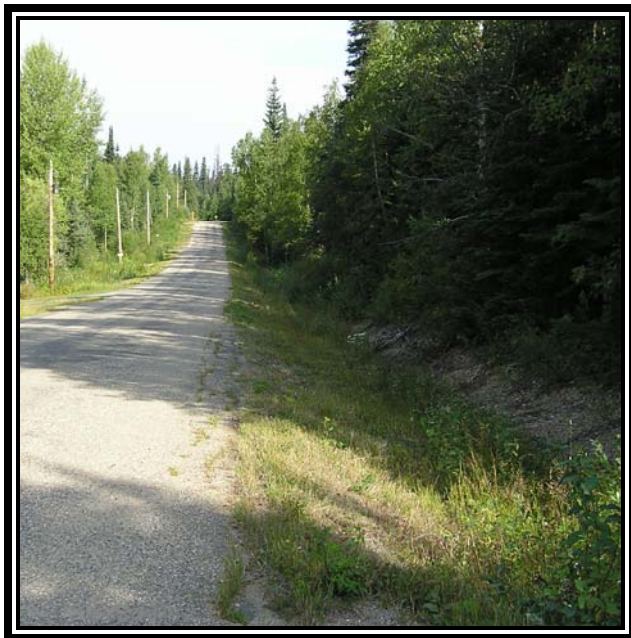

Adams Road Construction Start

At the Regional Board meeting on August 20, 2009 the RDFFG was authorized to enter into an agreement with Sharp Construction Ltd. to construct the Summit Lake Community Sewer System.

The contractor is gearing up to start with vegetation clearing along Adams Road to facilitate the installation of the mainline on the east side of the road.



The area north of the Community Hall will have the most dramatic transformation as a considerable amount of trees will be removed to accommodate the sewer mainline and the equipment needed for directional drilling of the connections under the road. Consideration has also been given to future maintenance requirements of the sewer mainline. The contractor is working with the engineer to minimize the amount of landclearing required for the mainline and the service connections.

The engineering firm of Dayton & Knight Ltd. will have a representative on site during the construction of the sewer system. If you have questions or require information on the project please contact the onsite representative. The engineer's main priority is to oversee the construction so there may be times that they cannot answer your inquiry right away but will be more than happy to get back to you in a timely manner.

Curbstop connections at property line

The contractor will be along Adams Road to place a stake at the property line of each lot to indicate where the curbstop would be situated. If the proposed location for the curbstop conflicts with the homeowners plan for the installation of the grinder pump (i.e. it is on the wrong side of the house) please let the contractor know as soon as possible. The engineer & contractor will work with the homeowner to find an alternative siting for the curbstop.

Project Updates

This newsletter was only sent to those properties along Adams Road as they are the ones that are initially impacted.

As the project develops, newsletters will be sent out to keep residents informed of the progress.

Information on grinder pump purchases and deadlines will also be made available.
