**NOTICE OF  
ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS**

Public Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, July 18, 2019, the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George intends to proceed with final passage and adoption of Foothills Boulevard Landfill Biogas Purchase Agreement Authorization Bylaw No. 3132, 2019 unless at least 10 percent of the persons qualified as electors petition the Regional District to not proceed without first obtaining the assent of the electors by voting.

Bylaw No. 3132 would authorize the Regional District to enter into a purchase agreement with FortisBC Energy Inc. for the sale of Biogas and for the granting of access to FortisBC Energy Inc. to and for use of a portion of the Lands for the purpose of operating and maintaining its facilities on the Lands. The area affected by Bylaw No. 3132 includes all municipalities and electoral areas within the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George.
