Temporary Use Permit issued for Trans Mountain work camp

The Regional District has approved the issuance of a Temporary Use Permit for a work camp being set up by Trans Mountain Pipeline ULC near Valemount. The work camp use is in conjunction with the proposed Trans Mountain pipeline expansion project. The camp will consist of temporary ATCO trailers (containing dorms, kitchens and rec rooms) and associated parking. The camp will house approximately 600 people with the capability to expand to 900 people.

Community Grants

The Board approved the following requests for Community and Recreation Grants:

- \$2500 to the Pilot Mountain Volunteer Fire Fighter Club for volunteer appreciation
- \$14,450 to the Buckhorn Volunteer Firefighters' Association for apparatus equipment
- \$10,800 to the Buckhorn Recreation Commission for insurance, sea-can concrete slab, administration expenses and swimming lessons
- \$35,000 to the Tabor Lake Clean Up Society for the purchase of a weed harvester
- \$2500 to the Pineview Seniors for a Christmas dinner
- \$2900 to the Giscome School PAC for swimming lessons
- \$18,000 to the Willow River Volunteer Fire Department for operating expenses
- \$500 to the McBride and District Housing Society for start-up expenses

Community Grants cntd

- \$5000 to the Ozalenka Alpine Club for cabin and trail maintenance
- \$1000 to the Valemount Community Sports Day for insurance and facility rental
- \$1000 to the Valemount JCR Adult Committee Society for program equipment
- \$3000 to the Valemount Senior Citizens Housing Society for contract administration expenses

The Board also approved the following allocations:

- Electoral Area A Community Grant-in-Aid of \$20,000 be allocated to the Salmon River-Lakes Community Endowment Fund.
- Electoral Area F Community Grant-in-Aid of \$18,000 be allocated to the Willow River-Upper Fraser Community Endowment Fund
