ADDENDUM No. 1

Invitation to Tender CS-18-06 SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF CHAIN LINK FENCE OPIE ST. PROPERTY

*The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Invitation to Tender (ITT) to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Invitation to Tender Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the ITT Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Tenderers shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their tender submission, failure to do so may result in a non-compliant tender.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.*

The following questions were brought forward at the mandatory site visit held June 28, 2018.

- 1) Can brush removed during the preparation of the fence line be left on site?

Regional District's Response: No, the brush must be removed from the site.

- 2) Will the existing fence along between the Regional District property and Belterra be removed?

Regional District's Response: That is yet to be determined, for the purposes of preparing your tender, please quote based on the 32m of fence as shown on the Site map included in the ITT.

- 3) Scope of work calls for water proof caps, does that mean that they are to be cemented on with silicone?

Regional District's Response: The ITT states "caps and overhangs will provide a waterproof fit", the intent is that the cap will be tight fitting to minimize the possibility of anything getting into the post.

- 4) Is fence to be run along the top of the bank along the Ospika side?

Regional District's Response: Yes.

- 5) If the Contractor runs into a large tree along the fence line, will it need to be cut or will the fence go around it?

Regional District's Response: At this time it is believed that the trees and brush are small, if this becomes an issue during the work the Project Manager will determine the best option with the preference at this time to be going around it.



The Project Manager has confirmed that there are no City of Prince George set-backs effecting this project. A survey plan will be provided to the successful tenderer at the start of the project. Tenderers are to submit their tender based on the linear feet in the tender. Should changes be necessary to the work of this ITT, they will be addressed through Section 8 PAYMENT, clause 4. There may be some other work taking place on the site at the same time the fence is being constructed, i.e. parking lot work. The Contractor doing the fencing work may need to be coordinated through discussion with the Project Manager and other contractors working on the site

Submissions from Tenderers who did not attend the Mandatory Site Visit will be rejected.
